PPGCL commits to:

- Comply and/or exceed all applicable environmental legislation(s) by Central Ground Water Authority (CGWA)
- Conduct expert-led assessments for operating station and office location to determine the RWH potential
- Gainfully utilize overall 40 % RWH potential in the organization. RWH utilization% shall be agreed in consultation with CEO.
- Implement well designed and engineered, environmentally sound technologies and best practices for efficient RWH systems
- Widely communicate this policy and inculcate environmental consciousness amongst all its stakeholders
- Review this policy once in three years
- Apply this policy to the establishment of PPGCL and its employees
